Licence requirements: The age to obtain a Boat licence is 16, upon successful completion of the BoatSafe course you will be issued a Statement of Attainment & a statement of competency. When you present these documents to a Queensland transport centre you will be issued with a boat licence for a fee of \$34.85 no further testing done. The same procedure is followed for PWC licence. An eyesight test is required if you don't hold a current driver's licence.
